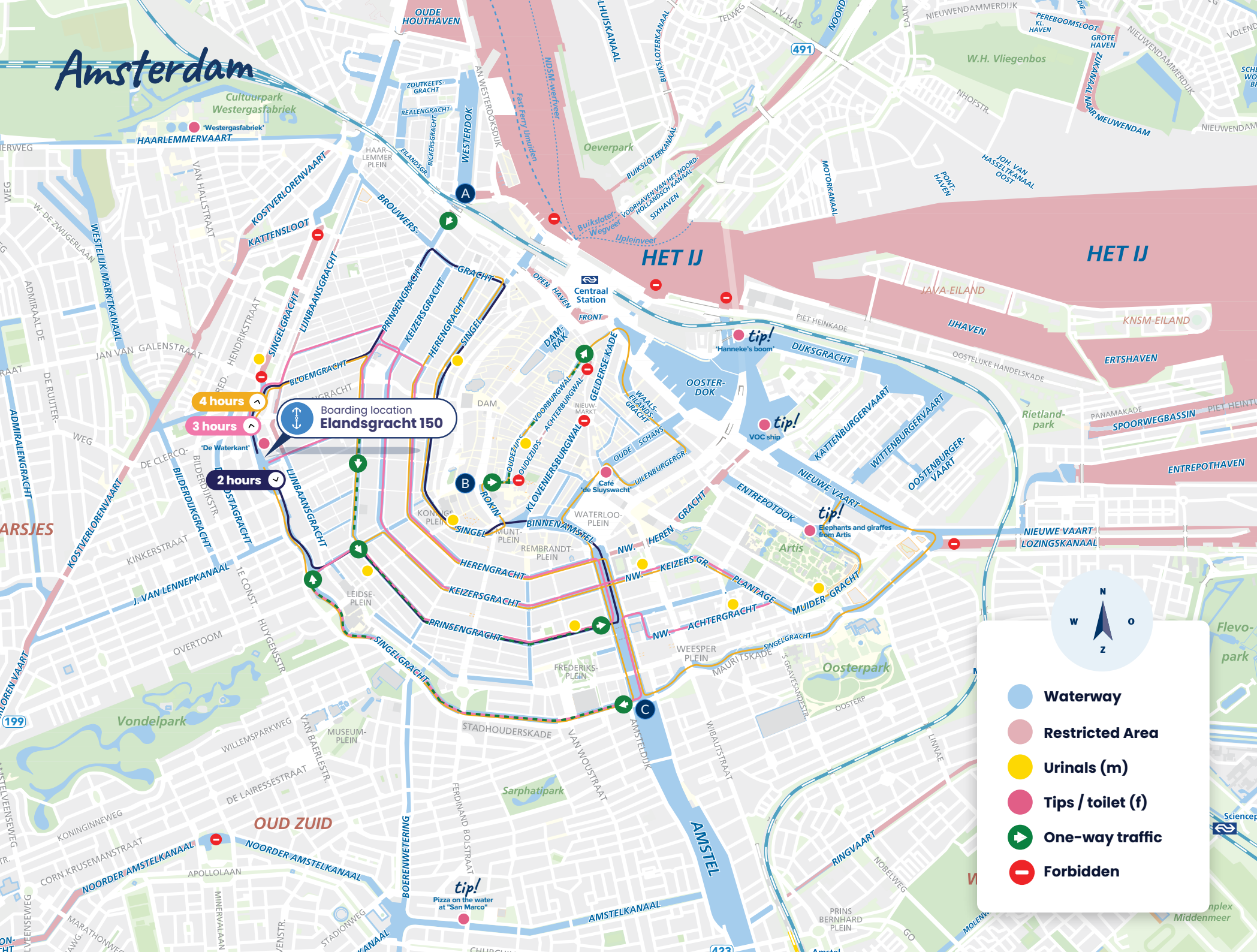


# Amsterdam

## Sailing rules on the water

- Safety first! Don't take any risks.
- Stay on the starboard (right) side of the canals and approach bridges and crossings with caution, watch for other vessels.
- The speed limit is 6 km/h. Adjust your sailing speed to the traffic situation. Need to stop? Put the joystick in reverse.
- It is prohibited to sail the boat when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Amplified music is prohibited on board.
- It's not allowed to moor under trees, bridges or other places where there's a sign that says you're not allowed to moor.
- There are no toilets at the dock, keep this in mind.
- Respect the privacy of people alongside the canals, don't cause any disturbance.
- Give way to commercial boats (i.e. tour boats).
- Stay clear of the "IJ" and the "Kostverlorenvaart" (see map).
- The **A** Prinsengracht, **B** Grimburgwal and **C** are one-way (see map). If you are driving in the wrong direction, you are risking a fine.
